



Symposium at Hebron University (HU) on "The Russian war on Ukraine and its impacts on the European Union and the Arab world"

(March 29, 2022)



As part of the activities of the of the "Jean-Monnet-Module Project 2020-2023: A Foundation to build on – and a Bridge of Intercultural Understanding (FICU)" on Tuesday, 29th March 2022 an international online symposium in the field of European studies under the title "The Russian war on Ukraine and its impacts on the European Union and the Arab world" was conducted at HU. With an audience of more than 100 persons and with Dr. Belal Al-Shobaki as the moderator, the symposium included three contributions from three researchers in the field with subsequent discussion:

- 1. Dr. Azam Hussain (Doha) on the European-Russian relations with a special focus on energy policies.
- 2. Dr. Ibraheem Rabayeh on the impacts of the crisis on the Arab region.
- 3. Ala' Al-Barghouthi (Sweden) on the crisis between the European Union and Russia with a special focus on related refugee issues.
