Field Trip from Hebron University (HU) to selected institutions in Bethlehem (November 23, 2022)

As part of the activities of the "Jean-Monnet-Module Project 2020-2023: A Foundation to build on – and a Bridge of Intercultural Understanding (FICU)" implemented at Hebron University (HU), a field trip related to the European Union was conducted from HU on Wednesday, 23rd November 2022. With Ms. Yusra Qawasma (lecturer at the College of Law and Political Science at HU) as the guide, the trip included a visit to the *municipality of Bethlehem* as well as to *The Center for Social Development at Palestine Ahliya University, Bethlehem*.

The field trip was aimed at giving the students, who traveled together from Hebron to Bethlehem, insight into the fruitful cooperation of Palestine and the European Union, respectively into how with the latter's support specific projects – among others in the field of academic and social development, for instance concerning the young people and the women in Palestine – are conducted successfully on the ground. One of the activities that were introduced in this context in detail is the "U Solve" project conducted in a cooperation of the *municipality of Bethlehem* and *the Ahliya University, Bethlehem*.
